

Suggested items to bring to camp:

- Sleeping bag/Sheets/Blankets (Platform tents twin size beds/ Cabins Full size beds)
- Clothes to sleep in
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Personal items (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, other toiletries)
- Towel & Shower shoes
- Extra clothes/shoes/socks
- Rain Gear
- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle
- Camp Chair
- Food/drink/snacks (Trading post will be open.)
- Cooking equipment
- Trash bags
- Class A Uniform

The following rules are enforced at the Lawhorn Scouting Base:

- 1. NO pets or other animals are allowed on BSA property. (Registered service animals are permitted.)
- 2. NO alcoholic beverages or illicit substances are permitted on camp premises.
- 3. NO fires or other heat sources are allowed in tents, Adirondacks, cabins or any other camp structure.
- 4. All vehicles must be parked in one of the camp designated parking lots.
- 5. NO one may ride in the back of a truck or trailer; seat belts must be worn by everyone in a moving vehicle.
- 6. The speed limit at camp is 9 MPH. Pedestrians ALWAYS have the right of way. (When driving through camp always be aware of your surroundings.)
- 7. Closed-toed shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals may only be worn for showering purposes.
- 8. Two-deep leadership is required at all times for youth. BSA Youth Protection guidelines must be practiced; leaders AND parents must be trained.
- 9. Bicycles are not permitted.
- 10. All fuel for lanterns, stoves, etc. must be handled only by adults. Fuel must be secured and locked away.
- 11. NO Firearms or ammunition of any kind are allowed at camp.
- 12. Fireworks are prohibited.
